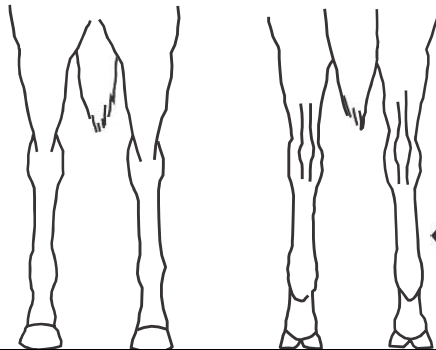
Right Side of Horse



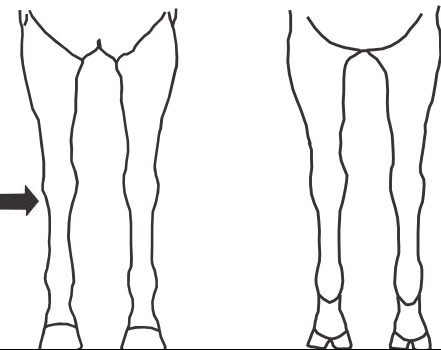
Left Side of Horse

Put hair follicles together and secure with tape to a clean sheet of paper. Insert into an envelope labelled with the horse's identity and seal envelope. Do not place into plastic Ziploc bags.
